Heather Myers from the Pride of the Susquehanna attended the LFDD Event and had an opportunity to talk with Rick about the Blues Cruise. She would still like to see that happen.

Also, Rick talked with Cindy from the Steelton VFW to reconfirm everything for IBC, New Years 2011. All is good.

Buster acknowledges Rick for all his hard work in PR; advertising, flyers, Website, etc.
